2010 Youth Acknowledgment and Waiver

The sailing programs offered by the Pacific Corinthian Youth Foundation are always conducted with safety as the first consideration. However, sailing is an outdoor physical activity with inherent risks. In any water activity, such as sailing, injury can occur, including death. Injury is also possible from the improper use of boats, and bumps, bruises and more serious injuries are possible. Even walking about on the docks or in the training facility has some risks. Falls are always possible and the docks present tripping hazards with the possibility of stubbed toes, and splinters.

In order to minimize the chance of injury, PCYF personnel check over the boats, the docks, and the facility each day for hazards. Hazards that can be eliminated are dealt with through repair or reporting to the appropriate person or agency. Hazards that are inherent to the sport or area will be pointed out to students. The Behavioral Rules and Guidelines set for the classes also aim to reduce the risk of injury by forbidding behavior such as roughhousing or running on the docks and by requiring the wearing of PFDs (life jackets) whenever the students are on or near the water.

PCYF classes are built around the US Sailing philosophy of "safety, fun, and learning." Safety is our first priority because our students can't accomplish the goals of having fun and learning if they are not safe.

Waiver Agreement

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2010 Youth Behavioral Rules and Guidelines

The Pacific Corinthian Youth Foundation has developed the following behavioral rules and guidelines to help ensure a safe, rewarding and fun learning environment. It is important that you and your child review these rules and guidelines, sign the form and return it prior to the start of the session in which your child is enrolled.

Appropriate behavior is expected at all times.

- 1) Classes start and finish promptly at their scheduled times. Students should be dropped off at the site no earlier than 15 minutes before the start of class. Students must be picked up promptly at the end of class. PCYF will not take responsibility for children who have been dropped-off or picked-up at a location other than the training site.
- 2) PCYF supports a team environment and no student shall be allowed to leave until all boats and other related equipment are properly stored and put away for the day.
- 3) The word of the instructors is absolute, and students are expected to obey the instructors at all times.
- 4) All students must take a short swim test the first day of class that consists of treading water and swimming along a dock or in a pool.
- 5) Lifejackets (PFDs) will be worn at all times whenever a student is on the docks, or in a boat.
- 6) Shoes, or other foot protection approved by the instructors, shall be worn at all times.
- 7) As further outlined in the Parent's Guide, students are responsible for their own sun protection which should include at a minimum, hats, sunscreen and sunglasses.
- 8) Observe the boundaries, both on the water and on the shore, as established by the instructors.
- 9) No running on the docks, climbing on boat racks, docks, trailers, or rocks near the shore.
- 10) Students will pick up their own trash, and are expected to keep their belongings in a neat and orderly fashion.
- 11) Students will show respect for their peers, the instructors, and other persons.
- 12) Absolutely no throwing of objects is allowed.
- 13) No obscene language.
- 14) No other behavior that is disruptive or otherwise interferes with the daily sessions.

Consequences for failure to observe the above rules and guidelines vary according to the nature of the infraction, but can include loss of privileges, and "time-out." Any verbal or physical abuse, or if your child's behavior jeopardizes his/her own or another's safety, will result in early dismissal from the class and a warning to both the parent and student. A second incident will result in the student's dismissal from the remainder of the session. There will be no refund of tuition or fees.
